Music Activity Course Group:

Three one-hour classes required: MUAC 1371, one of 1301, 1311, and one of 1331, 1341, 1351, 1361, and 2141 (Pre-req. 1331 or 1341). **Note:** MUAC 1221, 1231, plus the other three MUAC classes are pre-reqs. for MUED 3021, which must be taken in Spring Semester 3.

*Licensure for teaching in the State of Arkansas requires one additional semester of internship beyond and after the completion of the degree requirements. The courses required during the semester of internship are MUED 4301 Seminar for Professional Entry into Music Education, MUED 451V (4 or 8 hours) Student Teaching: Elementary Music and MUED 452V (4 or 8 hours) Student Teaching: Secondary Music.
