### **UA Staff Members Make Presentations at National Conference**

Two University of Arkansas staff members on the ISIS Project are making presentations this week at the international Alliance 2008 Conference in Las Vegas, Nev. The annual conference is designed for higher education, government, and public sector users of Oracle|PeopleSoft software applications.

On Tuesday, Karen Jennings, ISIS training coordinator, presents, “Stack the Deck for Successful Training.” The session focuses on the behind the scenes activities necessary to create a successful training session.

Mary-Ann Bloss, ISIS communications coordinator, is serving as chairperson of the Project Management and Life Cycle track for the conference. In addition, on Tuesday she will facilitate the “Birds of a Feather,” a discussion of project management topics that is open to all conference participants.
