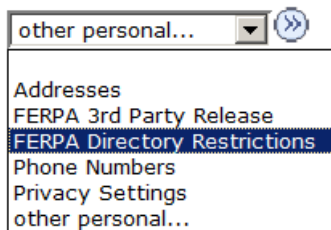



**FERPA**

As a student at the University of Arkansas, you have the right to withhold any or all personal information from being released to the public, including in the student directory. The *Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act* (FERPA) is a federal law that protects the privacy rights of a student's education record.

Students can adjust their public information settings through their myISIS Student Center.

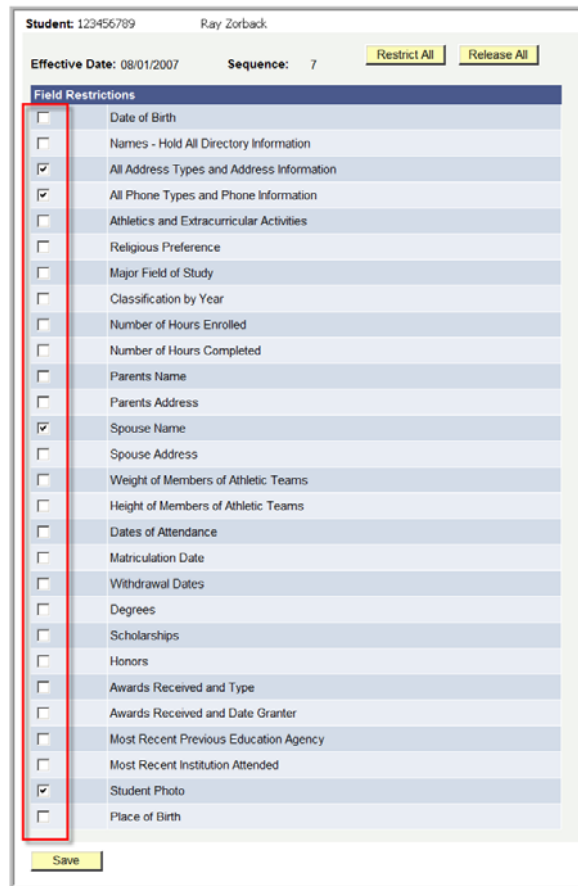
1. Log on to your *Student Center* page.
2. Click the drop-down window under the **Personal Information** title bar.



3. Select FERPA Directory Restrictions.
4. Click the arrows icon .



5. Click the [Edit FERPA/Directory Restrictions](#) link.



6. Check the boxes next to the corresponding information you wish to keep private.

**NOTE:** Click the **Restrict All** button to withhold *all* personal information.

7. Click the **Save** button.

**NOTE:** To allow specific people to view your student record, select **FERPA 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Release** in the drop-down menu shown in Step 2 of this document. This will take you to the *Consent to Release of Education Records* page.
