

Disability Services Committee

(Appointed by the Provost)

This committee exists to monitor disability needs and services for students within the schools and colleges and to promote consistency among the approaches and services provided. Members will also provide a liaison between their school, college, or unit and the Center for Educational Access. The committee will be chaired by the Director of the Center for Educational Access and will meet at least once each term.

Members will include a faculty representative nominated by the Chair of the Faculty Senate and, ex officio, one of the directors of the Teaching and Faculty Support Center chosen by the three co-directors. There will also be a representative from each dean's office (including the School of Continuing Education and Academic Outreach, the Library, and a representative position that will rotate among the offices of Admissions, Registrar's Office and Financial Aid) to represent the school, college or unit. Each dean will nominate someone to represent the school, college or unit who holds the position of associate dean or a comparable position, who is knowledgeable regarding disability compliance needs and practices, and who is assigned to work with individuals in the school, college or unit in implementing policy and procedures in this area.
