**\*This course is required for the AS degree at NWACC but is a not major requirement for the BSA degree in the Bumpers College. It will, however, count as a general elective required for the BSA degree.**

**3-3 Pre-Law Program:** Exceptional students in the Pre-Law concentration may enroll in the Law School in their fourth year provided the following requirements have been met: (1) completed all University, College and Department core requirements for the Pre-Law concentration, (2) completed 12 hours in the upper division specialization list (see the BSA degree with a Major in Agricultural Business check sheet) (3) a cumulative grade-point average in all college or university course work of at least 3.50 without grade renewal, and (4) a LSAT score of at least 159. A student may substitute law school course work for the remaining total hours required for the bachelor's degree in Agricultural Business.
