The State of Arkansas requires that all newly admitted U of A students comply with the two-dose measles Immunization Policy. Print this document and follow these instructions.

**Please read carefully:** Failure **to complete as instructed could result in class registration delays.**

**Part 1 is mandatory for all students.** Send immunization documents directly to the Pat Walker Health Center per the information below. Please do not send immunization documents with materials being sent to other university departments.

### **Part 1 Measles, Mumps, Rubella Required for all Students.**

As stated above, you must comply with the State of Arkansas two-dose measles Immunization Policy. If a second immunization is needed, it must be the combined MMR vaccine.

**REQUIRED:** (one of the following three options is required to fulfill Part 1):

- **First Option: 2 doses of MMR vaccine.**

Obtain copies of your immunization records (see acceptable sources below) and attach them to this form. *Students should retain original documents.* Copies of immunization records will be destroyed after entry into the University database.

Acceptable records of your immunizations may be obtained from any of the following:

- Copies of your personal immunization records (“baby book”).
- Copies of physician office records.
- Copies of Health Department immunization records.
- Copies of high school or previous college immunization records. (Note: Transcripts from other institutions which are sent to another office at the U of A are not forwarded to PWHC. You will still need to provide us with this documentation).

Please continue to the instructions on the next page.

**REQUIRED:** (continued):

- **Second Option: Titer (Blood test) results** proving immunity to measles (rubeola) and rubella. Documentation is required.
- **Third Option: Exemption:**
  1. Medical Exemption: The physical condition of the above named person is such that MMR immunization would endanger life or health, or is medically contraindicated due to other medical conditions.

2. Religious/Personal Exemptions: Only the Arkansas Department of Health can provide this exemption. The Department of Health can be contacted by calling (501) 661-2169.

**Part 2**

**Tuberculosis (TB) Screening**

**Completion is required for all students in any of the following categories.**

If one of the two criteria below apply, TB screening is required:

\_\_\_\_ Born in Asia, Africa, Central or South America, or Eastern Europe and not a permanent resident.

\_\_\_\_ Contact with a person known to have active Tuberculosis.

If you have checked any items above you must attend the International Student Health Clinics held during the Fall and Spring semesters when you are notified by e-mail from the Pat Walker Health Center.

**OR**

Provide documentation of TB Screening (PPD Mantoux skin test read and documented in millimeters of induration) done in the U.S. or Canada within the past 6 months. Chest x-rays will be required for anyone with a positive skin test. X-rays can be taken at the Health Center or you may bring chest x-ray films taken within the last 6 months. A negative chest x-ray is not a substitute for a skin test.

Provide documentation of prior treatment of active TB disease.

**Recommended Vaccination**

Meningococcal Vaccine Arkansas Act 1233 of 1999 requires us to inform you of this rare, but potentially fatal, bacterial infection commonly referred to as meningitis. Students living in residence halls have a slightly higher risk of contracting this disease. The University of Arkansas recommends that all students living in residence halls or Greek housing receive a meningitis vaccine. The Meningococcal vaccine is available at the Pat Walker Health Center.
