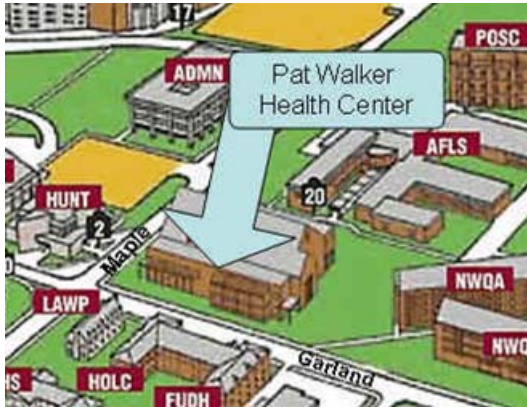


The University Pharmacy is conveniently located on the corner of Maple and Garland, one block north of the Union.

The Pat Walker Health Center

Pharmacy proudly serves U of A students, faculty and staff. To meet your needs, the Pharmacy carries a broad spectrum of prescribed medications, as well as over the counter medications. Skilled pharmacists counsel patients on medications, drug interactions and sound practices. Students, faculty and staff find the pharmacy conveniently located, user-friendly, and very efficient.

Sometimes students bring prescriptions from providers from other parts of the state of Arkansas or the United States. Our pharmacists are not able to fill these prescriptions. As a *licensed student health pharmacy* in the state of Arkansas, pharmacists are able to fill the prescriptions of patients under the care of Pat Walker Health Center physicians and nurse practitioners. The pharmacy may also serve patients under the care of Health Partners providers, a Northwest Arkansas network to whom some patients are referred from the Pat Walker Health Center.

If students are in need of a prescription, the Pat Walker Health Center invites these students to make an appointment with a physician or nurse practitioner, request and send medical records from their provider at home and establish care with the Pat Walker Health Center.

Prescription Cards

The Pat Walker Health Center Pharmacy accepts a number of insurance cards. Each patient should bring their prescription card to the pharmacy for review.

Payments

For added convenience, patients can pay for their medications with cash, a check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover credit cards or debit cards. The Pharmacy also accepts RazorBucks.

Generic Medications

Pat Walker Health Center pharmacists are committed to providing high quality and cost-effective medications. For this reason, patients are often offered generic drugs which are equal in effectiveness to name-brand medications and an excellent economic alternative that results in great savings for our patients. The pharmacists are very willing to discuss any concerns about generic medications with patients.

Getting to the PWHC

Patients come to the Pat Walker Health Center by walking, bicycling, riding the Grey or Maple Hill buses, or by car. Limited parking is available with a parking pass on the west side of the building.

Some Fast Facts...

- Carry your insurance cards with you! Remember a prescription insurance card is often a different card from health insurance.
- The Student Health Fee covers office visits to the Primary Medical Clinic, CAPS, Women's Clinic, Health Promotion and Education and many outreach programs. The Student Health Fee is not health insurance. Student health insurance is available for students in need of a health insurance plan.
