### Scholarships and Travel Awards

The UA International Agricultural Programs Office through its Global Studies Program provides scholarships and travel awards for students who participate in study abroad, international internships and faculty-led group study tours. Students must be enrolled in the Dale Bumpers College of Agricultural, Food and Life Sciences and earn academic credit to qualify for these awards.

GSP Scholarships and Awards are commonly used to cover a portion of the cost of the student's international flight, accommodations and in-country transportation. The amount of each award is determined by the type and length of the study program and available funds. Awards range from \$200 to \$1,000.

To apply for the awards, a student must submit the GSP Scholarship and Travel Award Application and Plan of Work Report to the International Agricultural Programs Office, Global Studies Program, 425 Hotz Hall, Fayetteville, Arkansas.

#### ■ Scholarships

The **Richard S. Locke Endowed Scholarship for Study-Abroad** is open to undergraduate students in Bumpers College who plan to study abroad for a semester or year. Two scholarships of \$1,000 each are available each year.

The **Cordia Harrington “the Bun Lady” International Experience Endowed Scholarship** provides partial coverage of costs associated with international travel each academic year for students studying abroad under one of the Bumpers College-directed programs. Scholarships range from \$200 to \$1,000.

The **Preston E. La Ferney International Agriculture Endowment** provides funding for students in Bumpers College who participate in study abroad and internship experiences. Scholarships range from \$200 to \$500.

The **Wayne E. Sabbe Endowed Scholarship in International Agronomic Study** is open to undergraduate (junior or senior) and graduate students in the Department of Crop, Soil, and Environmental Sciences (CSES). Students must submit the formal CSES Scholarship Application and GSP Plan of Work Report to the Scholarship Committee, Department of Crop, Soil, and Environmental Sciences, 111 Plant Sciences Building. The selected student(s) will be awarded \$200 to \$1,000.

■ **Travel Awards**

**GSP Travel Awards** are available to assist students in Bumpers College who participate in study abroad, internships or study tours. The award is used to cover transportation and accommodation expenses. These awards are limited and based on available funds. Awards may range from \$200 to \$500.

**GSP Study Tour Awards for UA Faculty** are available to faculty who lead group study tours for three or more students enrolled in Bumpers College. Faculty members should complete the Global Study Tour Application, and students who participate must complete the Plan of Work Report and forward to the International Agricultural Programs Office, Global Studies Program, 425 Hotz Hall. Awards range from \$200 to \$500 depending on available funds and may cover a portion of the accommodations, in-country travel or other expenses.
