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### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF GRADUATE APPLICATION** **APPLICATION DEADLINE IS DECEMBER 1**

The application packet for the University of Arkansas Clinical Psychology Graduate Program consists of seven (7) items:

1. This instruction sheet
2. Departmental Application
3. Graduate School Application
4. Minority Status Reporting Form.
5. Letters of recommendation
6. GRE Scores
7. Transcripts from all undergraduate and/or graduate work.

1. Please read the instruction sheet first, before filling out the other forms.
2. The Departmental Application must be filled out and the supporting materials provided. Please answer the two questions in a few paragraphs. You may submit a personal statement in addition to answering these two questions, if you desire.
3. The Graduate School Application must be filled out completely and returned to the Psychology Department **without** the \$40 application fee. If you are an international student, you must enclose a check or money order for \$50. This is University policy. The Psychology Department will pay the application fee of \$40 for those students admitted to our program.
4. The Minority Status Reporting Form is optional and can be completed by individuals who wish to be considered as members of minority groups. Failure to include this form with your application IN NO WAY affects the review of your file.
5. Letters of Recommendation. We do not have official forms for these letters. We require a minimum of three (3) letters, although we will accept as many letters as you submit with your application. Please have references sent by those psychology professors who can best judge your chances for success in graduate study in psychology. Professors in other field can also send letters, provided they are well acquainted with
6. your capacity for academic, clinical, and scientific work and the requirements for successful graduate study in psychology.
7. Graduate Record Examinations (GREs). We must receive scores for the Aptitude test (Verbal, Quantitative and Analytical Writing). We do not require the advanced psychology test for admission consideration, however, if you have taken it, please

submit your scores. You must submit GRE scores for your application to be considered. Please request that your GRE scores be sent to Clinical Psychology (Department Code 2001) at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville (Institution code R6866).

8. **Two (2) official** copies of your transcripts for all undergraduate and graduate work must be sent **directly to the department by** the appropriate officials of these institutions. We will not accept personal copies or reproductions of your copies for review purposes. They must be official transcripts.
