1. MUTH 1003 Basic Musicianship does not count toward the 16 hours of required theory; entering students will take a diagnostic exam and may not be required to take the course.
2. Students who place out of either or both of the Class Piano courses may take any other MUAC or MUAP (Secondary) Class to fulfill the 2-hour requirement.
3. Satisfactory completion of the term paper in this class will fulfill the Fulbright College writing requirement.
