1. MUTH 1003 Basic Musicianship does not count toward the 18 hours of required theory, but may count as a free elective; entering students will take a diagnostic exam and may not be required to take the course.
2. Students who place out of any or all of the Class Piano courses may take any other MUAC or MUAP (Secondary) Class to fulfill the 4-hour requirement.
3. Prerequisites for enrollment in MUAP 310V include passage of the Junior Barrier (generally taken at the end of the sophomore year); and performances on two Student Recitals.
4. Satisfactory completion of the term paper in this class will fulfill the Fulbright College writing requirement.
