1. MUTH 1003 Basic Musicianship does not count toward the 19 hours of required theory (or as a free elective); entering students will take a diagnostic exam and may not be required to take the course

3. MUHS 4703 Survey of String Literature is not offered every semester and should be taken when offered during the junior or senior year.
4. Satisfactory completion of the term paper in this class will fulfill the Fulbright College writing requirement.
5. Prerequisites for enrollment in MUAP 310V include passage of the Junior Barrier (generally taken at the end of the sophomore year); and performances on two Student Recitals.
