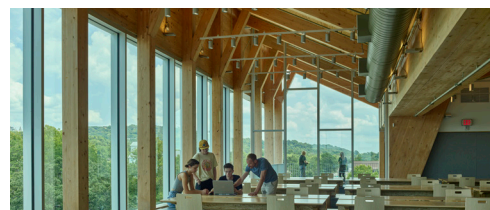
Multi-User Silicon Carbide Research and Fabrication Facility (MUSiC)
