The U of A is set to open the Multi-User Silicon Carbide Research and Fabrication Facility (MUSiC) in late 2025.

This facility will enable the federal government – via national laboratories – businesses of all sizes, and other universities to prototype with silicon carbide, a capability that does not presently exist elsewhere in the U.S.






